Each year, a new Detachment Commander is elected and spearheads a Detachment Project for the benefit of veterans within the state of New Jersey. This year, I have agreed to work on a **joint American Legion Family project** with Department Commander Ray Miller and Department President Fran Derin.

Commander Miller has selected the following items, which have been approved by the Department Executive Committee, to comprise the Department Project for Legion Year 2018-19.

Aside from donations received from Legion Posts, Auxiliary Units, and Sons of The American Legion (SAL) Squadrons, donations from other sponsors are always welcome.

The following is a synopsis of the 2018-19 Department and Detachment Project:

- 1) \$25,000 – Tom Kennedy Hoboken Post 107 (6 Homeless Veterans Bedrooms)
- 2) \$25,000 – DMAVA (Emergency Transportation of Veterans)
- 3) \$16,000 – Veterans Haven North (Cafeteria and Meeting Rooms Furniture)
- 4) \$30,000 – Veterans Haven South (15 Passenger Van)
- 5) \$16,000 – Brigadier General Doyle Cemetery (Renovations of Chapel Restrooms)

The total estimated costs are \$112,000.

My goal is to raise \$25,000 towards the overall project. I am respectfully asking for your support. Please consider a donation to help me complete this very reachable goal for a very worthy endeavor.
